Covenant is based upon God's Unconditional limitless love for us and expressed thru His mercy and grace towards us.

More covenant foundation:

"All I have is yours" In covenant relationship, each party represented understands that everything they have is at the disposal of the other party if they have need of it.

A look at the parable of the prodigal son. Luke 15:11-32

Father had two sons and divided his estate between them. vs 11-12

Younger son gathered everything together, journeyed to a distant country and squandered his possessions. vs13

Spent everything, and a famine came and he began to be in want. vs 14

Hired himself, who sent him to feed swine. vs15

He came to himself vs 17

Father saw him while yet he was far away and had compassion on him, and he ran and embraced his neck and kissed him. vs 20

Son repented vs 21

Father put the best robe on him, put the ring on his hand and shoes on his feet. vs22

Bring the fattened calf, let us eat and be merry. For the son of mine was dead, and is alive again; he was lost, and is found. vs 23-24

Other son comes in vs 25

Other son was angry vs 28

Father tells son, you are always with me and all that I have is yours. vs 31

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Romans 8: 14-17 AMP

14 For all who are *allowing themselves to* be led by the Spirit of God are sons of God.

15 For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading again to fear [of God's judgment], but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons [the Spirit producing sonship] by which we [joyfully] cry, "[b]Abba! Father!" **16** The Spirit Himself testifies *and* confirms together with our spirit [assuring us] that we [believers] are children of God.

17 And if [we are His] children, [then we are His] heirs also: heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ [sharing His spiritual blessing and inheritance], if indeed we share in His suffering so that we may also share in His glory.

Romans 8:32 AMP

32 He who did not spare [even] His own Son, but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also, along with Him, graciously give us all things?

2 Corinthians 1:20 KJV

20 For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us.

Matthew 7:7- 12 AMP

7 "[c]Ask *and* keep on asking and it will be given to you; seek *and* keep on seeking and you will find; knock *and* keep on knocking and the door will be opened to you. **8** For everyone who keeps on asking receives, and he who keeps on seeking finds, and to him who keeps on knocking, it will be opened. **9** Or what man is there among you who, if his son asks for bread, will [instead] give him a stone? **10** Or if he asks for a fish, will [instead] give him a snake? **11** If you then, evil (sinful by nature) as you are, know how to give good *and* advantageous gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven [perfect as He is] give what is good *and* advantageous to those who keep on asking Him.
