- 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18
- I. Spirit, Soul, and Body
 - A. Hebrews 4:12
 - 1. Power = Effective, productive of due result
 - 2. Divides between both soul and spirit two separate things
 - 3. Soul = Psyche and Spirit = Pnuema (wind, breathe, current, breeze, ghost)
 - B. 1 Thess. 5:23 and AMP.
 - 1. Same greek words for soul and spirit.
 - 2. Paul is praying that their whole being be kept complete and be found blameless at the coming of Jesus.
 - a) The physical is less important than the spiritual but it does matter.
 - (1) There is a reason that Jesus had to come and live a physical life and die a physical death. God wanted to redeem every part of our being.
 - b) It's important that we honor, and serve, and represent God with all parts of our being.
 - (1) Mark 12:30 Love the Lord your God with all...
 - (2) 1 Corin. 6:12-20
 - C. Our spirit is perfected/glorified, but not our carnality... yet
 - 1. Romans 7:22-23
 - a) 2 Corin. 4:16
 - 2. Romans 8: 11-16 His spirit bears witness of our spirit because our spirit now has been remade to bear the image of His spirit.
