## The Cross Road - You're Gonna Make It!

Road to the Resurrection - Week 3

How do we get there? Hebrews 10:19-24

- I. Full Assurance
  - A. Vs. 22 Full Assurance of faith
    - 1. We need to have fully convinced and assured ourselves in Christ.
      - a) Eph. 3:12-21
        - (1) When we assure ourselves focusing on the love of God and His son Jesus, then confidence and strength will come through His Spirit.
        - (2) But when we are focusing on the wrong things, fear will be present.
          - (a) Adam and Eve were immediately afraid of God and hid from His presence when they sinned.
        - (3) Jeremiah 17:7-8
      - b) Hebrews 2:14-15
  - B. Coming into the Holy of Holies freely with boldness in the old testament was never even a thought. It was always done with fear and trembling. Hoping that that they had effectively cleansed themselves before entering God's presence.
    - 1. We have a "new and living way."
    - 2. Boldness = boldness, freedom, liberty, openly (opposite of secretly)
- II. Living in the Throne Room
  - A. Make up your mind to hold fast to your profession no matter what.
    - 1. C. S. Lewis "One always feels better when one has made up one's mind."
  - B. Vs. 23 Without Wavering. = not leaning, firm, unbent, unyielding, resolute
    - 1. Why would the author worn us to not waver if there wasn't going to be anything to tempt us to waver?
      - a) 1 Corin. 15:1-2 "keep in memory" = Hold fast, bind, arrest; take possession of, lay hold of
        - (1) We have to make up our mind to stick to it no matter what. We must "own it"
  - C. At the "cross roads" you have to make a decision and Christ paid too high a price for us to draw back and not be empowered by God's presence.
    - 1. Don't let the work of Christ go to waist in your life just because things are hard. Or because they get easy!
  - D. The strength needed in order to hold fast will come from the presence of The Lord.
    - 1. Acts 3:19
    - 2. Encourage yourself in The Lord Psalm 31:24 "Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the Lord."

- a) If you do the work to stand up against the enemy trying to wear you down, stand up and take courage, and God will give you the strength that you need.
- 3. The Throne Room is no place for a victimized mindset or for self-pity.
  - a) It is a place of reverence, thanksgiving, worship, and peace
  - b) Hebrews 10:39 "We are not of those who draw back..."
    - (1) Keep pressing in!
    - (2) Hebrews 3:12 and evil heart of unbelief
