The Spirit of Life - Week 9 (11-29-23)

2 Timothy 1:6-10

- I. Luke 10:9 Dunamis vs Exousia
 - A. Exousia Authority Ability; privilege; force; capacity; competency; freedom
 - 1. Matt. 7:29 and 28:18
 - a) We must recognize the authority that we have been given before we will ever use it
 - (1) You will never get pulled over by a cop that forgets that he has been authorized and empowered by the local government.
 - (2) We must be trained in how to handle it confidently and gracefully. Like a law enforcement officer
 - b) 1 Corin. 8:9 We cannot get overly confident with the freedom that we have been given.
 - (1) We can allow our freedoms to go to our head and forget that it was a gift given for the purpose of service.
 - (2) With great power comes great responsibility
 - B. Dunamis Force; power; miracle; ability; abundance; meaning. Also translated as mighty, strength, virtue, mighty work
 - 1. Acts 1:8, 1 Timothy 1:7
 - 2. The gun that enforces the authority of the badge
 - 3. God does not give you Dunamis without first giving you Exousia
 - a) Hebrews 11:11 Sara receive strength (Dunamis) after God made a covenant with she and Abraham.
- II. God's power is in His presence
 - A. Exodus 33:7-17
 - B. Mark 5:30 Virtue = Dunamis
 - 1. It wasn't about the physical touch. Hundreds of people were touching Him in this moment, but this woman *touched* Him.
 - Just because God's presence and power is there doesn't mean it automatically manifests.
 - (1) Luke 5:16-17
 - (2) Mark 6:5-6
 - C. Things that block God's power in our lives (DL):
 - 1. Spirit of fear
 - 2. Secret sin
 - 3. Doubt
 - 4. Religious ungodly tradition
 - 5. A wounded spirit
 - 6. Unyielding hard hearted spirit

- a) These all limit our connection with God and the Holy Spirit; His presence.
- D. The key that unlocked the power of God in Jesus' life
 - 1. Matt. 3:13-17
 - a) A very personal anointing of the Holy Spirit that drove Him into His call and ministry.
 - 2. It's that anointing of the Holy Spirit that will usher in the power of God in our lives as well.
 - a) Acts 1:8
 - (1) If you read through the book of Acts you will notice that there are multiple times where they are filled with the Spirit. We need to be continually seeking a deeper connection with God and filling with His Spirit because that is where the power is.
 - b) Don't forget that the power is for much more than just your self development!
