Guard Your Gifts

The Gifts of God - Week 18 (3-22-23)

Psalm 137

- I. Don't Neglect Your gift 1 Tim. 4:14-15
 - A. Neglect = to be unconcerned, Webster give little attention or respect to
 - B. He has given them to us for a purpose They were meant to be used!
 - C. Neglect Leaves it sitting to deteriorate, leaves it vacant and liable to be stolen (the thief comes), easily forgotten when it's just sitting on the shelf.
 - D. Protect your gifts but don't hide them!
 - 1. You don't hide a light under a bushel Matt. 5:14-16
 - 2. A thief can't easily steal your tools while you're using them
- II. The wrong motives and in the wrong way
 - A. If the enemy can't get you to neglect your gift, he will try his best to get you to use it for his "glory" instead of for God's glory.
 - 1. King Saul 1 Samual 15:10-35
 - 2. 1 Kings 12:1-15
 - 3. Not using the gifts of God in decency and order 1 Corin. 14
 - a) Always have the benefit of the church in mind when operating in your gifting! (1) Vs. 12
- III. Using and Growing in your Gifts
 - A. God's will for us 1 Thes. 4:3-5
 - 1. The Gentiles don't know God, and therefore cannot control their vessel with holiness and honor.
 - B. 1 Peter 1:13-2:10
 - 1. 1:16 "...Be ye holy; for I am Holy..."
 - a) Holy Sacred, pure, blameless, consecrated
 - (1) Can be interpreted "Into the holiest"
 - (a) Hebrews 9:6-14
 - i) Verse 8 Holiest
 - 2. God's plan and purpose for us is to be a more and more perfect reflection of His glory
 - a) Purpose in the New Testament = prothesis Purpose; plan; setting forth, show exposed
 - (1) Can also be translated Showbread (Heb. 9:2 same word)
 - (a) Showbread (Bread of the Presence) 12 loaves set on a pure gold table in two rows. Always placed right next to the Holy of Holies. (Lev. 24:5-9)
 - (b) What made the showbread was it's exposure to the presence of God. Like Moses
 - (2) Romans 8:28
 - (a) "Called according to his purpose (Holiness by exposure to His presence)

- (3) 2 Tim. 1:6-9
 - (a) Not by our works, but by exposure to the presence of God
 - (b) 2 Tim. 2:20-21
 - i) If we want to be prepared and fit for the master's use, then we must get ourselves in His presence and allow His holiness to cleanse us.
