## The Gift of Gratitude

The Gifts of God - Week 6 (11-30-22)

1 Thes. 5:18

- I. Key to happier living
  - A. Stability
    - 1. "It's not happy people that are thankful but thankful people that are happy."
    - 2. Happiness is no longer a rollercoaster dependent upon physical things and people but rather on thankfulness of God and His faithfulness (which is always constant).
      - a) You don't have much control of you happiness/emotions, but you have complete control of your gratitude.
        - (1) "Rejoice in the lord always: and again I say, Rejoice." Philip. 4:4
          - (a) This is expected and even commanded from God. We are fully capable of living a life of gratitude because God supplies what we need in order to accomplish what He asks of us.
  - B. "Discouragement cannot grow in a grateful heart."
  - C. Peace Philip. 4:6-7
    - 1. An environment of gratitude is conducive to God's presence and His peace.
      - a) Jesus said "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you..." John 14:27
- II. Key to our Sanctification
  - A. 1 Thes. 4:3-7
    - God's will is not only to give thanks in everything but also to sanctification and holiness
      - a) I believe that Thanksgiving is the road to our sanctification and holy living.
      - b) We can't be grateful for something that we have not yet recognized, and it is God's grace that carries us to our sanctification.
  - B. For gratitude to be present there must first be knowledge and recognition of something or someone's positive impact on you.
    - 1. Romans 1:21
      - a) You cannot <u>honestly</u> recognize God and His positive impact on your life and Not be grateful.
        - (1) Have you ever truly sought after God from your heart and come away ungrateful??
      - b) To come to God at all is to recognize His existence, and to be grateful for His gift of life.
        - (1) "Gratitude goes beyond the 'mine' and 'thine' and claims the truth that all of life is a pure gift." Henri J. M. Nouwen
      - c) Even if we only know a little about God and His nature we know enough to be grateful for eternity because He will never change and will always be faithful.
  - C. Gratitude is the polar opposite of Entitlement!

- 1. There is nothing that will kill your gratefulness and happiness in life than an attitude of entitlement!
- 2. You won't be grateful in receiving what you think you deserve.
  - a) Entitlement is rooted in selfishness and pride!
    - (1) 1 Peter 5:5 and James 4:6
    - (2) A quick path back to gratitude is a good dose of humility! Either by circumstance or by revelation.
- D. Content Philip. 4:10-13
  - 1. Dangers of greed
    - a) Prov. 1:19 Taking away from your own life!
      - (1) God has truly designed to operate in gratefulness and worship to Him.
    - b) Prov. 15:27 Troubling not just yourself but your whole house.

## III. Key to Living by Faith

- A. If I'm continually reflecting and being thankful for God's character and faithfulness, then naturally my faith will grow. "faith comes by hearing...." and hearing, and hearing!
- B. Jesus knew that the Father always heard Him, but still He said "...I thank thee that thou hast heard me. And I know that thou hearest me always..." John 11:41-42
  - 1. Our gratitude is an expression of Faith!
- C. Philip. 4:6
  - 1. If we are commanded to bring our requests to God with thanksgiving, then our gratefulness must effect our faith.
- D. Mark 11:22-24 If you believe you have received it when you pray, you might as well be thanking Him for it!
  - 1. Expressing gratitude toward God for something that has not yet manifested is an act of faith based on His word and faithfulness.
    - a) "...He calleth those things that be not as tho they were." Romans 4:17
    - b) Romans 4:18-21 Abraham gave glory to God before the promised son was born because he had waxed strong in faith.
