The Resurrection Power of Jesus (4-20-22)

Philippians 3:7-10 10-that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death.

1) Activate- (a doing, a driving or a impulse- if a device or process is activated, something causes it to start working) To make active; cause to engage in activity!

A. Romans 10:9-13 and 1 John 1:9

We first accept Jesus as our Lord and Savior. Accepting Him into our heart and lives. Believing that He was raised from the dead (the resurrection power) and was the ultimate sacrifice for our sins. So we can come boldly before the throne.

B. Hebrews 11 (the Faith chapter)
