## Training the Next Generation

The Gospel of The Kingdom - Week 2.5 (3-2-22)

Duet. 6:4-9 & 12

- Jude 3 We need to be contending for the faith! Contend = Strive in contest or rivalry or agains difficulties to struggle for
- We have taught people **about** the gospel for a long time, but we need to train/show people how to **live** the gospel.
- Jesus hand picked His disciples, showed them what it looked like to preach the gospel, and then sent them out to do the same.

## I. It Starts with Me

- A. The first person you have to learn to lead is yourself.
- B. You can't give what you don't have, and you can't take someone somewhere that you have never been.
- C. 3 "P's" of personal discipleship
  - 1. **Priorities**
    - a) "...Love the Lord thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might." Duet. 6:5
  - 2. Practice
    - a) "Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ..." Philip. 1:27
    - b) "And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus..." Colossians 3:17
  - 3. Patience
    - a) "Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience." James 1:3
- D. It starts with me, but we are not meant to do it alone
  - 1. Philippians 1:27
    - a) It takes all of us doing our part to spread the gospel.
      - (1) We all need to be united by the same spirit living by the same spirit.
      - (2) When we are all being led by the same spirit, we will all be communicating the same message by the way that we live.

## II. The Home

- A. Joshua 24:15
  - 1. If it's only going to be me and my family serving God, so be it.
  - 2. He took responsibility for the direction of his own family.
  - 3. Because Joshua was established in his walk with God, he then made sure that his family would follow suit.
- B. Don't Forget set up constant reminders!
  - 1. Duet. 6:8-9

- 2. God knew that if they were not in the habit of recognizing God for their blessings, then they would forget about Him.
- 3. Judges 2:10 It only took one generation to forget!
  - a) Psalm 71:15-18
  - b) Psalm 145:4
- C. Acts 16:30-34
  - 1. This man's decision to follow Jesus impacted "all his house."
- D. 1 Timmothy 3:5
  - 1. You be the Bishop of your home!
  - 2. The way that you lead your own life and your home will reflect how well you can lead other people with the Gospel.

## III. Beyond

- A. The Way that We Live Ephesians 2:14-15
  - 1. When we are leading ourselves and our families to live the gospel it will spill over to the people outside of your home.
  - 2. We will be living as lights shining wherever we go. Our very presence will be radiating life to the people around us.
  - 3. Sometimes we never know that impact that we have made on other people just by the way that we live our lives.
- B. Getting in The Way Jude 20-23
  - 1. Sometimes we have to just get in the way, and be very intentional.
