Thy Will Be Done - Week 13 (8-20-23)

1. John 1:10-13 Not the will of the flesh; not the will of man, but of God.
2. Other people may not always be in agreement with you concerning the will of God. Acts 21:10-14.
3. If we are in tune with God, we should know the will of God for our own given situation better than anyone else
4. If we were to walk in unbelief or in denial, God might point out our sin by the Holy Spirit, or a prophet, such as Nathan did with King David. 2 Samuel 12:5-7.
5. The Holy Spirit doesn't convict us so He can condemn us, but so we can be reconciled back to God and walk in the perfect will of God. Romans 12:1-2. Ephesians 5:6-17 (know the word, know the will).
6. It is our soul responsibility to seek out the will of God for ourselves and our family.
7. If God has placed you in a leadership role, you will need to know His will concerning that role to be successful in it. Hosea 4:6
8. Pastors quote, "What is the will of God in the fire?"
9. Is the will of God the same under the air conditioner?
10. What harm has come to us thus far for serving Christ? Phil. 1:28-29, Acts 5:27-28, 38-39.
11. If it is a struggle for us to live for Christ, what will it be to die for Him?
12. What is the cost for compromise?
13. Compromise dries up the fruit of the Spirit.
14. The truth that empowers the gospel of Christ has stood the test of time and evil empires.
15. The spirit of anti-christ is being revealed daily.
16. We don't study evil to recognize it, we study truth.
17. If we are fearful, we will never experience the purifying of the Fire of God. 1 Peter 5:10.
18. We will either stand for the truth or fall because of it. 2 Timothy 4:1-5
19. The words of a hymn says, "On Christ the solid rock I'll stand, all other ground is sinking sand".
20. There are reasons why God instructed Joshua to have 12 men to gather a stone a piece, sand doesn't make good altars.
21. What we are doing as Christians will help those that come after us.
22. Just as Israel had to choose who they would serve, America is being asked the same question today, and people are making a choice every day. Joshua 24:13-17.
