## Friends of God

- A. Proverbs on Friends
  - 1. Proverbs 18:24 (AMP) and 27:17
- B. The Tribe of Levi Exodus 28:1-2 and 32:26-28
  - 1. Aaron was called out by God. He did not seek the office of a priest.
    - a) The Levites did not have an inheritance.
    - b) Instead of requiring all of the first born in Israel for Himself, He took the tribe of Levi for His ministers and servants.
- C. The Original King-Priests Gen. 1:27-28
  - 1. Their service to God was the result of their relationship with God.
    - a) Made in His Image. They communed with Him in the Garden
- D. Examples
  - 1. Gen. 5:24 "And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him"
  - 2. Gen. 18:17-18
    - a) Abraham's established relationship with The Lord gave him insight into what The Lord was doing.
  - 3. Exodus 33:11
    - a) Friend Rea = Friend, darling, favorite, lover; comrade, companion, neighbor, one another.
    - b) This kind of relationship isn't just for Moses.
      - (1) Numbers 12:8
- E. John 15:13-16
  - 1. More than just a business relationship. It's personal.
  - 2. Verse 14 Our commitment to Jesus' commands reveals that we are His friends.
    - a) 1 John 5:1-5
      - (1) True friends love to serve one another.
      - (2) Grievous = weighty, burdensome, heavy, important
        - (a) Matt. 23 Verses 4 and 23
    - b) We still live in service to God, but it comes out of knowing the Father and His heart intimately.
    - c) It's better to obey than to sacrifice 1 Samuel 15:22
- II. Service to God
  - A. Back to 1 Peter 2:4-9
    - 1. Verse 5 We are living stones being built into a house for God's presence to dwell.
      - a) We are simply an extension of Jesus and His power and dominion.
        - (1) It glorifies God when we bear much fruit John 15:8

- (a) We bear (carry) the fruit, while the life and power of Jesus produces it through us.
- 2. Living sacrifices Romans 12:1-2
  - a) Our reasonable (rational) service is to be living sacrifices. No longer living for ourselves, but living for the cause and purposes of God.
    - (1) We do this by not being conformed by the world but by being transformed by allowing the Holy Spirit to renew our minds.
      - (a) This is unification with the Holy Spirit. Relationship. Friendship

## B. Verse 9

- 1. "...Show forth the praises..."
  - a) Sacrifice of praise Hebrews 13:15-16
    - (1) Hosea 14:2 (AMP) "Take the words [confessing your guilt] with you and return to the Lord. Say to Him, "Take away all our wickedness; accept what is good and receive us graciously, so that we may present the fruit of our lips (gratitude)."
    - (2) Isaiah 61:3-6 and 10-11
