Walk This Way/Wisdom From Above

Who Am I - Week 18 & 19 (8-7-24)

Psalm 23

- I. Always Moving Forward
 - A. Philippians 3:13-14 I Press toward the mark
 - 1. The big picture The Goal is always to know Christ
 - a) Even when God asks us to be still, it is for the sake of moving forward.
 - (1) Psalm 46:10 "Be still and know that I am God..."
 - (a) The being still facilitates our knowing Him which takes us deeper with Him.
 - 2. The smaller picture This is where God's wisdom is required.
 - a) We need God to direct our paths Proverbs 3:5-6
 - 3. What past things are we forgetting?
 - a) 3:9 Any of our own attempts at self fulfillment and self righteousness.
 - (1) Without a renewed mind we will not be able to move forward.
 - (a) "Think/Do/Get"
 - (2) We must think differently about how righteousness is attained
 - b) We can't just throw everything out the window.
 - (1) Wisdom will show you what experiences are valuable and what experiences are not worth holding on to.
 - (2) Paul's primary goal was to know Christ, and anything that's behind us that will restrict our progress is not worth holding on to.
 - (a) Intimacy is impossible without exposure and confrontation.
- II. New Things and Old Paths
 - A. Isaiah 43:18-21 A New thing
 - 1. 43:25-26 Until they acknowledge their sins and expose themselves to God, they cannot experience His righteousness and the new things that He is speaking of.
 - B. Jeremiah 6:16 Old paths
 - 1. The "old paths" are the ways of God. They refused to walk in the righteous ways of God, and wanted to make their own way.
 - a) Their "own way" was really just an imitation of what they saw the world doing.
 - C. God is wanting to do new things on the old paths.
 - 1. His way is always the way of truth and righteousness, but He loves to do things differently.
 - a) Historically God's spirit has pored out on His people in many different ways.
 - (1) Just because He did things a certain way "back in the day," doesn't mean He's going to do it the same way this time.
 - (2) Don't limit God by expecting the same old things!
- III. You Know the way
 - A. Matt 7:13-14 Straight and Narrow

- 1. The right way is NOT the path of least resistance!
 - a) If it was easy everyone would be doing it.
- 2. Verse 14 (AMP) "But small is the gate and narrow and difficult to travel is the path that leads the way to [everlasting] live, and there are few who find it."
- B. Jesus is only giving two options. One leads to life and one leads to death, and there is not in-between.
- C. John 14:1-5
 - 1. It doesn't always feel or look like I know the way.
 - a) Sometimes it seems quite obvious that God has intentionally cornered me next to the Red Sea so that my approaching enemies can come and slaughter me.
 - (1) They knew the way because they knew who to trust and follow.
 - b) The wisdom will come as we need it. But don't forget to ask!
- D. Colossians 2:6
 - 1. In the same way that you received Jesus by faith, so walk in Him by faith.
