David was operating under the old covenant and what He did was supernatural.

We have a better covenant based on better promises. Hebrews 8:6

Power of the Blood- Hebrews 9: 22 without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.

Hebrews 9:11 Christ as High Priest gave his own blood for the redemption of sins.

What is the difference between remission(forgiveness) redemption, sanctified and atonement?

Atonement [kaphar] in Hebrew means to cover. Old Testament or old Covenant blood sacrifice only covered the sins of the people.

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Leviticus 16 and 17 Please read through these chapters to understand the importance of the atonement for the children of Israel.

To redeem [exagorazo] in greek, it means to buy up, ransom, to rescue from loss,

Remission is also translated forgiveness in the new testament. Forgiveness [aphesis] in the greek means freedom, pardon-deliverance, forgiveness, liberty, remission. also to put or send away.

Ephesians 1: 7 states “ In Him we have redemption through His blood and the forgiveness(remission) of sins according to the riches of His grace. “

Sanctified [hagiazo] in greek, to make holy, purify or consecrate.
from [hagios] sacred, pure, blameless etc.. Hebrews 10:10, 10:14 10:29

Galatians 3:13-14 Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law,....

1 Peter 1:18-19 “ For you know that you were not redeemed from your vain way of life inherited from your fathers with perishable things, like silver or gold, but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.” MEV

1 john 1:7-9 **The precious blood of Christ cleanses us from all sin.**
